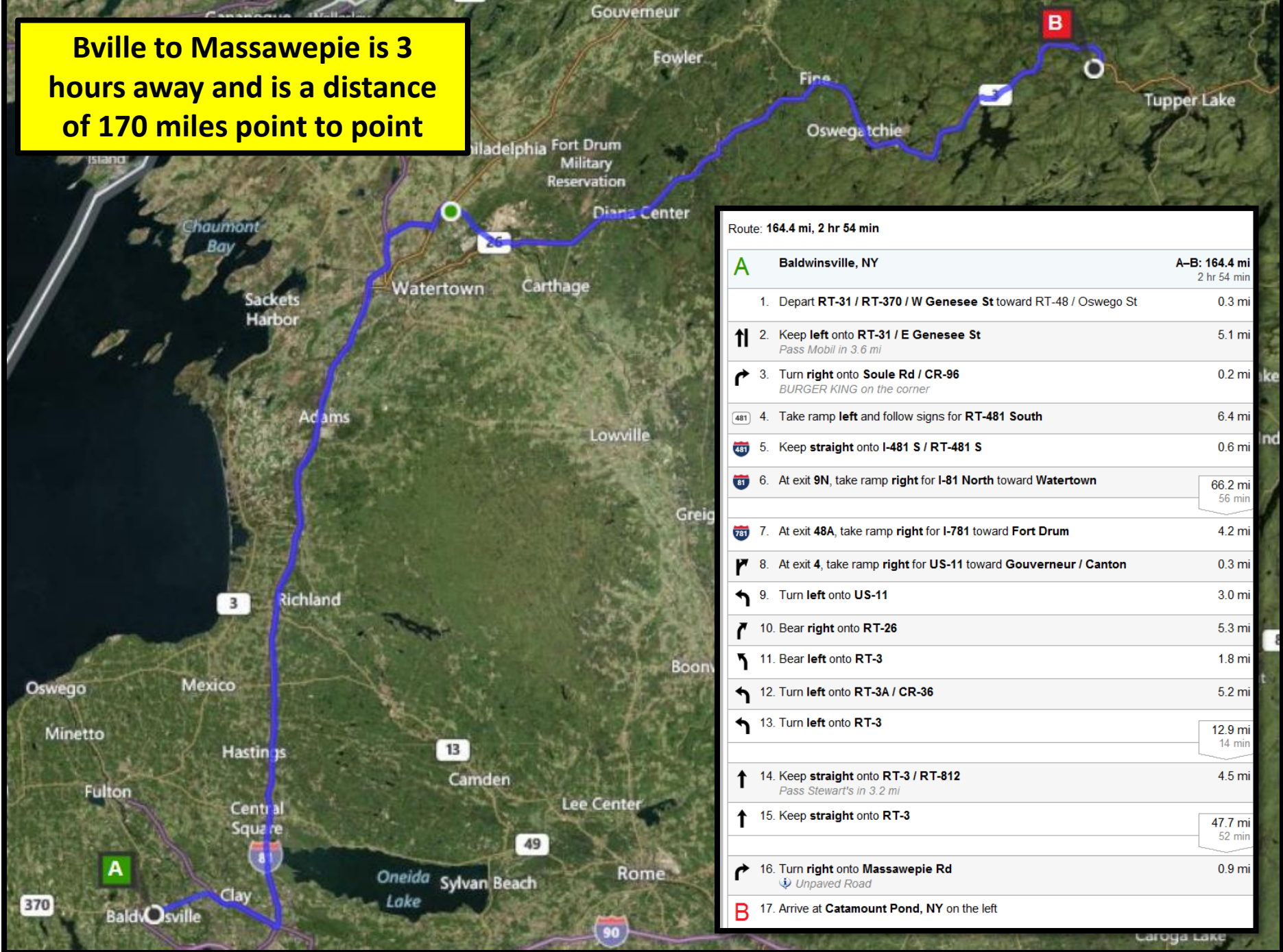

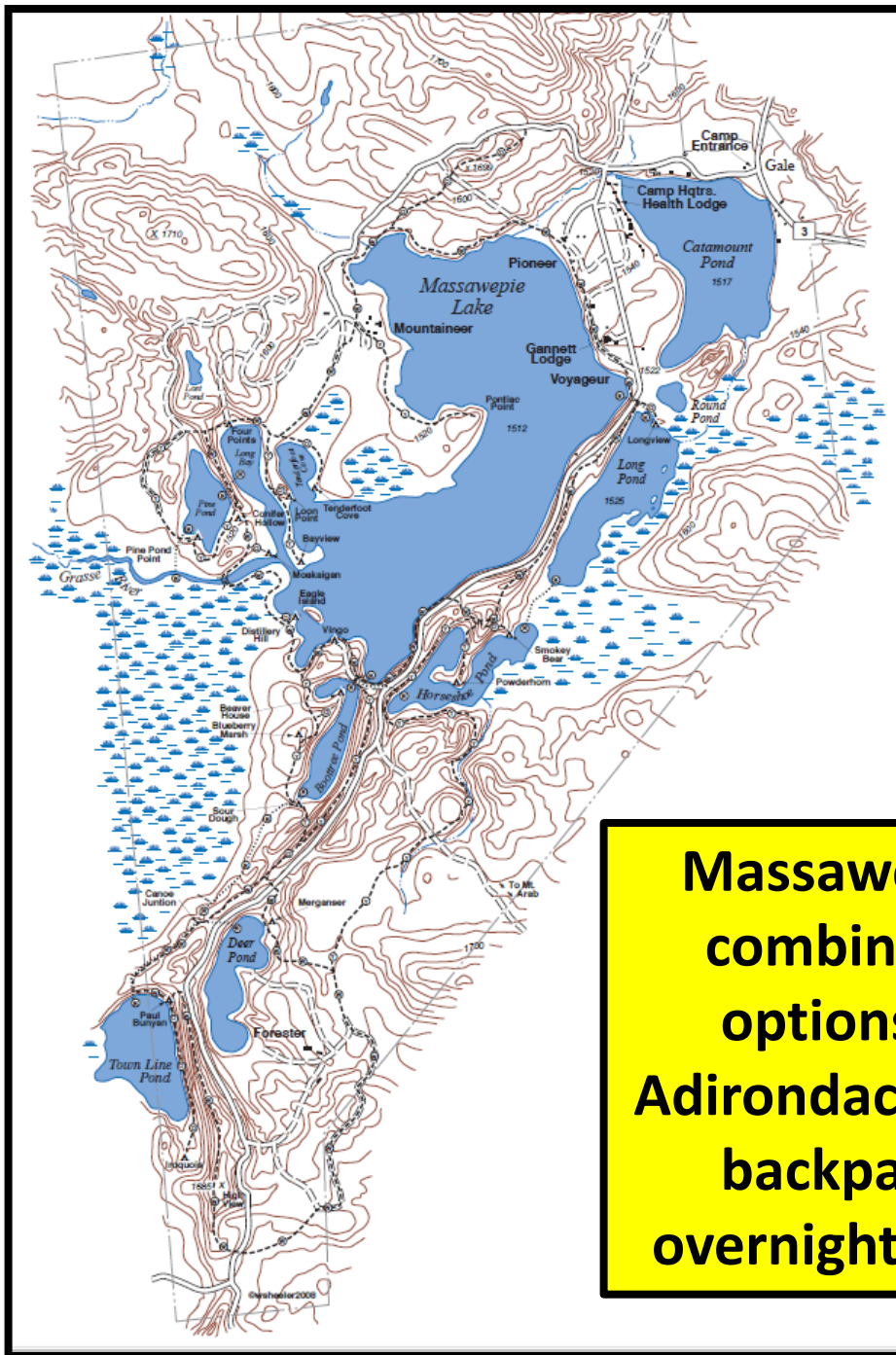


Bville to Massawepie is 3 hours away and is a distance of 170 miles point to point

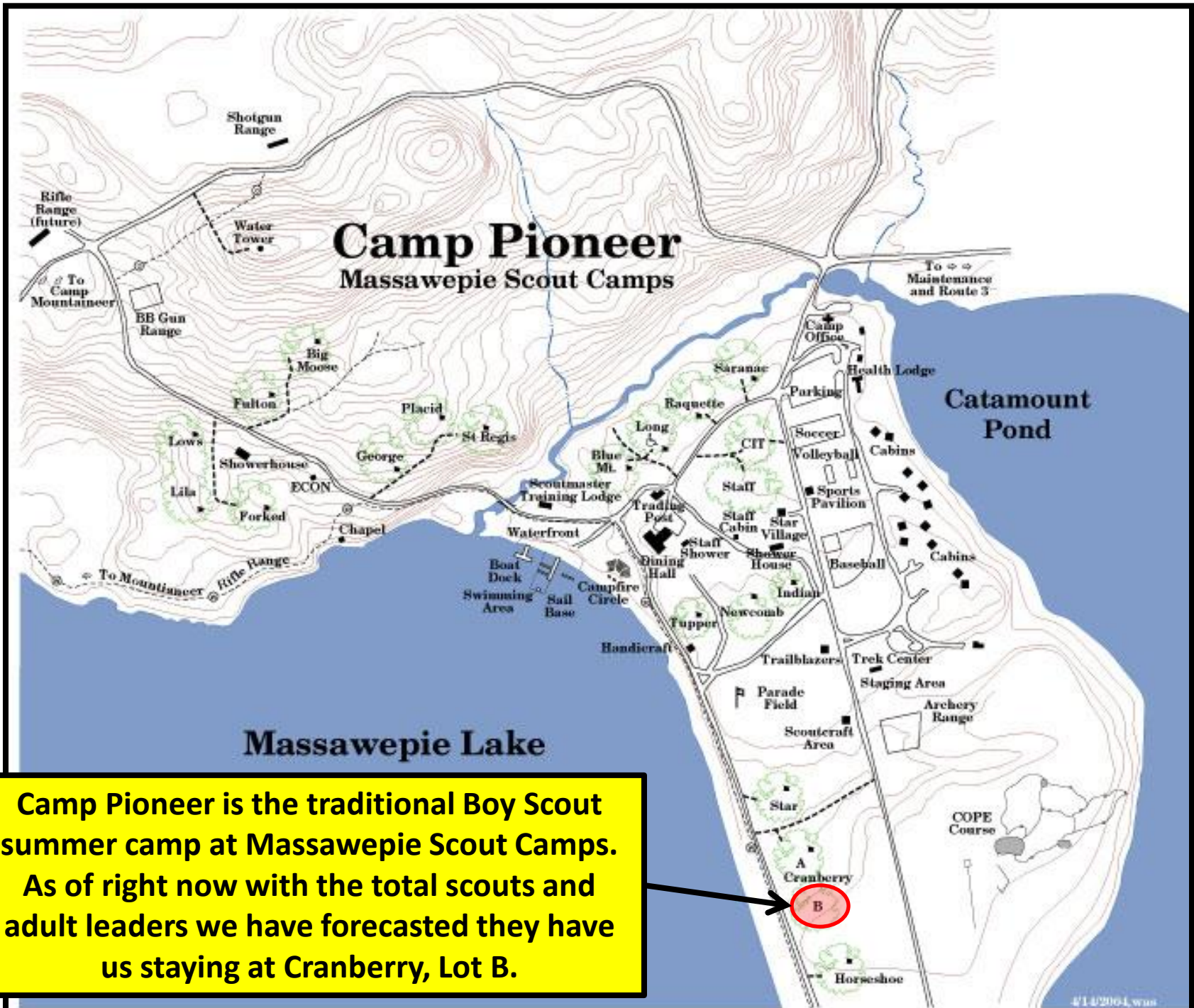
